New Business

Tsunami Functional Exercise (Sept 2007): This agenda item was postponed to the next meeting.

Presentation: Nancy Wood-Siglin presented the Emergency Plan for Pacific Veneer. The committee made a few minor suggestions but felt the plan was very good.

Discussion: Paul Dean reported that the Biodiesel Plant has a foam truck that is being made available to the Hoquiam Fire Dept. They are currently working on operator plans and hope to have a functional exercise that would implement the foam truck.
