- Ecology's Spill Prevention, Preparedness and Response Program (attached): A report of spills in GHC from 1998 – 2008 was distributed. There are two oil spill equipment caches in the county at The Port of GH and Quinault Indian Nation.
- The position for Deputy Director of Emergency Management is open and will close on June 19, 2009.
- 2010 Grant Application: Performance period runs from October 1, 2009 through September 30, 2010. Ken asked if anyone is interested in participating in the grant application process. To be considered, award applications must be received no later than August 14, 2009. The award priority will be given to jurisdictions to conduct joint/regional activities, to conduct Commodity Flow Studies, to develop or revise the Emergency Response Plans or the Hazardous Materials Annex to the County/Tribal Plan, and to conduct exercises of those plans. The LEPC needs to decide what the focus is going to be for the grant. This will be on the agenda for next month.
- The SO will be having a booth at the fair, August 5-9, 2009. Lynn will bring a sign up sheet to the next meeting for anyone wanting to help out at the booth. The group discussed what kind of materials to pass out. Moving to high ground, emergency plans for the individual communities, etc., were some of the topics talked about.
- Dow Chemical Company has completed its acquisition of Rohm and Haas as of April 1, 2009. They will be sent an invitation to attend the EMPC meetings.
- The City of Hoquiam's Emergency Management Plan is almost complete. It will be available for review by the LEPC in the near future.
- The LEPC By-Laws needs to be updated due to the changes in Emergency Management.
