



Appendix C Matrix of Technical Assistance and Funding Opportunities

The page setup for the matrixes on the following pages is designed for 11-inch by 14-inch paper for maximum reading enjoyment. However, if your printer cannot print on this paper size, you can reduce it down to common 8½-inch by 11-inch letter size in both the **Word** and **Adobe Acrobat** formats.

For **Word**[®]:

Simply go into the **File** drop down menu and click **Print**. Once you are in the **Print** screen, look in the bottom right-hand quarter of this menu screen. There you will see the **Zoom** features. Go to the command **Scale to paper size**; you will notice it says **No scaling** in the drop down box. Enter into the drop down box and immediately below **No scaling** is **Letter**; click this one so it pops up next to **Scale to paper size**. Now, all you have to do is click the **OK** button. You will find that these pages are quite readable even with this reduced size.

This will print out **ALL** of the matrixes. If you want to print a particular page or two, there are two ways of doing this.

1. You can go to the particular page, making sure your cursor is actually appearing somewhere on that page and go into the **Print** screen again and where it says **Page range**, click the **Current page** toggle. Do not forget to do the **Scale to paper size** command described above!
2. Do the same as above, but instead of using the **Current page** toggle, use the **Pages** toggle and enter the

appropriate page number(s) as they appear in the right hand bottom corner of the document.

For **Adobe Acrobat®**:

Simply go into the **File** drop down menu and click **Print**. Once you are in the **Print** screen, look in the middle right-hand side of this menu screen. There you will see the **Copies and Adjustment** features. Before **Shrink oversize pages to paper size** is a square toggle box; make sure that box has a check mark in it. Now, all you have to do is click the **OK** button. You will find that these pages are quite readable even with this reduced size.

This will print out **ALL** of the matrixes. If you want to print a particular page or two, there are two ways of doing this.

1. You can go to the particular page, making sure your cursor is actually appearing somewhere on that page and go into the **Print** screen again and where it says **Page Range**, click the **Current page** toggle. Do not forget to do the **Scale to paper** size command described above!
2. Do the same as above, but instead of using the **Current page** toggle, use the **Pages** toggle and enter the appropriate page number(s) as they appear in the right hand bottom corner of the document.
