1. Please consider this language in the "18.06.025 General Exemptions." section:  
(F) Maintenance of driveways and private access roads within the existing road prism provided that the maintenance does not involve the use of herbicides, hazardous substances, sealants or other liquid oily substances in streams, wetlands or their buffers.
2. 18.06.095(B)(2)(d), skips for (ii) to (iv) and omits (iii)

**Subject:** Grays Harbor County Code Critical Protection Area Update Process

Grays Harbor County hereby provides notice concerning the availability of the second draft of *Grays Harbor County Code 18.06*, as well as the related first draft of definition section *Grays Harbor County Code 18.02*. The code concerns the protection of critical areas, which are defined by Grays Harbor County and Washington State as *geologically hazardous areas, frequently flooded areas, wetland areas, fish and wildlife habitat conservation areas, and critical aquifer recharge areas*.
